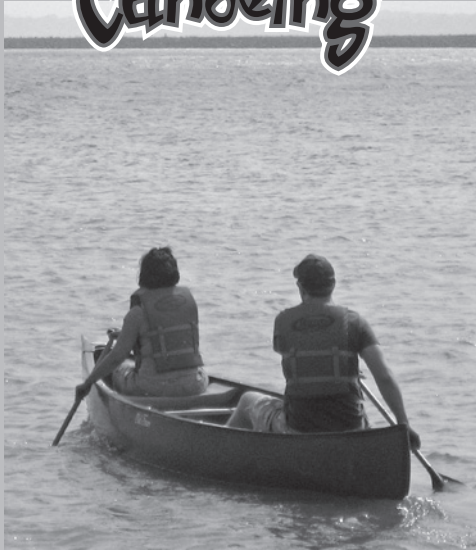

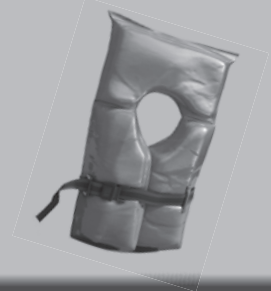
Canoeing
