The funding is designed to serve as a last resort for those in a shelter, on the street, in transitional housing or in imminent danger of becoming homeless. All funding will benefit households with incomes equal to or less than 50% of the area median income. The goals of the program are to increase energy efficiency and reduce the burden of utility bills, improve the quality of life by improving indoor air quality, buffering exterior noise, reduce pollutants and contribute to having a cleaning environment and healthier neighborhood by reducing energy consumption.
